

## **Wiltshire Council**

### **Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984**

#### **Temporary Closure of: Five Thorn Lane, C66 (Part) and Lower Seagry (Part), Seagry and Great Somerford (Ref: TTRO 5736)**

Notice is hereby given that Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all traffic:

##### **Phase 1**

Five Thorn Lane, Seagry; from its junction with Henn Lane to its junction with Great Somerford Road.

##### **Phase 2**

C66 (Part), Seagry and Great Somerford; from its junction with Five Thorn Lane to its junction with Dauntsey Road;

Lower Seagry (Part), Seagry; from its junction with C66 for a distance of approximately 660 metres in an easterly direction.

**To enable:** Avonline to carry out excavation works to lay cable.

##### **Phase 1**

**Alternative route:** via C82 – Great Somerford Road and vice versa.

##### **Phase 2**

**Alternative route:** via West Street - Startley Road – C82 – Five Thorn Road and vice versa.

**The closure and diversion route will be clearly indicated by traffic signs.**

This Order will come into operation on 01 March 2019 and the closure will run consecutively until 01 April 2019. It is anticipated that the works will take the stated duration to complete depending upon weather conditions. Access will be maintained for residents and businesses where possible, although delays are likely due to the nature of the works. The Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months.
