2. Minutes of meeting of October 15th.2014-- The minutes were approved as a true record of the meeting. Matters arising were covered in the Agenda of the present meeting.

4. Preparation for meeting with Wiltshire Council. -- A power point presentation is nearing completion. It will outline the main details intended for inclusion in the NP.
