036.16.	Wiltshire Council update - Cllr Sturgis reported on the following: There is no change to the W C grant and therefore savings will need to be made.

The Parish Council had previously objected to this application and requested the Wiltshire Councillor to call the application into committee – however this was not done as the parish council's objections were not classed as material considerations. The response received from the Planning Officer following queries from the Parish Council was considered to be abrupt and unnecessary.
