Minutes of an extraordinary Parish Council(PC) Meeting held on Thursday June 19th.at 7.00pm in the Community Room of Great Somerford School.

Purpose of meeting.

The meeting was called at short notice in response to the request from Wiltshire Council for the Parish Council to inform them,by Tuesday June 24th,whether the the PC was prepared to contribute towards the cost of the construction of a footpath in Dauntsey Road. At the time of the meeting this cost was likely to be a maximum of £10,000 which represents 25% of the estimated cost.

Although the consultation with residents of Dauntsey Road living near to the proposed path was still ongoing,the response to date was that the majority (over 70%) of respondents were in favour of installing the footpath.

After discussion it was proposed by Cllr. Hourigan and seconded by Cllr.Cole that the PC should contribute to the construction of the footpath up to a maximum of £10,000. A vote was taken and it was resolved unanimously to agree the proposal. Ratification of this decision will be sought at the next public PC Meeting.

The meeting closed at 7.30pm.
