2. No Exhibitor will be allowed more than one prize in any one class and can enter no more than 3 entries in a class.
3. No Exhibits to be shown that have previously been shown at Somerford Show.
4. All awarding of prizes is left to the judges' discretion.

6. Any complaint must be brought to the Secretary before 3pm on Show Day.
